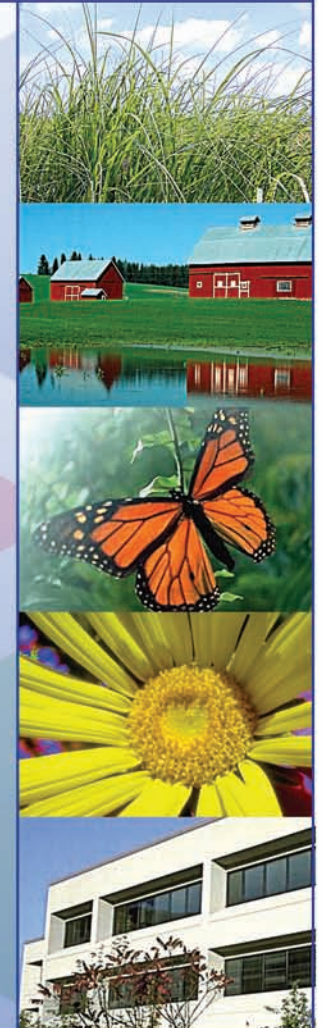
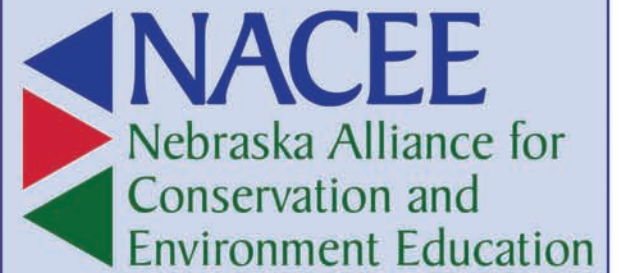

Vision

The Nebraska Alliance for Conservation and Environment Education (NACEE) seeks to foster an environmentally literate citizenry in Nebraska and serve as a leader in conservation and environment education.

About NACEE

NACEE was founded in 2001 as the result of a merger between two previous groups, NEEA (Nebraska Environment Education Association) and NOFEE (Nebraska Organizations for Environmental Education). NEEA focused primarily on teachers, while NOFEE was aimed at organizations. The groups realized that by merging, they could prevent duplication of effort and build a stronger, more cohesive approach to promoting environmental education.

Activities

NACEE is devoted to promoting and strengthening environmental education in Nebraska, and the group's activities reflect that mission. By working together, members of NACEE have been able to undertake large-scale projects that would be very difficult for any of them to complete on their own:

EE Master Plan

Using EPA grant funds, NACEE has coordinated the development of a Master Plan for Environmental Education in Nebraska. The plan identifies strengths and weaknesses in the state's current approach to EE, and lays out a series of objectives to improve the coordination and impact of EE programs.

The plan was developed through a series of workshops held throughout the state with input from a wide range of people with an interest in environmental education.

NACEE will continue working with as many EE partners as possible to implement the Master Plan.

Environmental Literacy Survey

In 2003, NACEE partnered with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln to conduct a survey of environmental literacy in Nebraska. This was the first comprehensive, scientifically-designed study of this type to be conducted in the state.

The survey results show strong support for environmental education in Nebraska. An executive summary of the survey was distributed in the spring of 2005 to the EE community, legislators, and others. The entire survey is available for download on the NACEE website at www.nacee.org.

Annual Conference

NACEE holds an annual conference for environmental education providers and other interested parties at various locations around the state. The conferences are designed with a mixture of sessions and activities to appeal to teachers, agency personnel, and other EE stakeholders.
